

Taking Action in Congress to Protect a Woman's Right to Choose

Congressman Eliot Engel's voting record in Congress has again earned him a 100% Pro-Choice voting rating from NARAL Pro-Choice America.

His record of working to protect a woman's right to choose and opposing all attempts to restrict or end the rights recognized in Roe v. Wade has also earned him the praise of leaders of organizations dedicated to keeping abortions safe and legal.

"Eliot Engel is a strong, effective and trusted leader in Congress on choice," Catherine Lederer-Plaskett, President of the WCLA-Choice Matters, stated.

Congressman Engel worked to defeat an amendment to an appropriations bill to end federal health care funds to Planned Parenthood

health centers. This would have had a serious impact on family planning and other services for low-income women and men.

He co-sponsored legislation supported by NARAL, NOW, Planned Parenthood, and WCLA-Choice Matters to improve women's health and reduce unintended pregnancies by expanding information about and access to birth control and family planning services. It would also provide information about and access to emergency contraception for sexual assault survivors.

Engel opposed attempts to cut funding for the Federal Food and Drug Administration's Office of Women's Health. He is a co-sponsor of the "Freedom of Choice Act," which would make a woman's right to choose a federal law.

He also co-sponsored legislation to make sure rape survivors are offered emergency contraceptives in hospital emergency rooms and that women in the military stationed overseas have access to the medication.
