Working in Congress to Protect a Woman's Right to Choose.

Year after year, Congressman Eliot Engel has worked in Congress to protect a woman's right to choose and opposed all attempts to restrict or end the rights recognized in *Roe v. Wade*. With two new Justices on the United States Supreme Court elevating the threat to *Roe*, Congressman Engel will do everything possible in Congress to protect a woman's right to choose.

Catherine Lederer-Plaskett, President of the Westchester Coalition for Legal Abortion-Choice Matters, called Engel a "dedicated, strong and effective leader on choice in Congress."

He is a co-sponsor of the "**Prevention First Act**." This legislation would expand information about and access to birth control and family planning services. It would make sure that sexual assault survivors receive information about and access to emergency contraception.

It also provides funding for teen pregnancy prevention programs and mandates that federally funded sex education includes medically accurate information about birth control.

Supported by NARAL, NOW, Planned Parenthood, and WCLA-Choice Matters, the legislation's goal is to improve women's health and reduce unintended pregnancies.

Engel is a co-sponsor of the "**Access to Legal Pharmaceuticals Act**" that requires pharmacies to fill all legal, valid prescriptions. The legislation was written to prevent pharmacists from refusing to fill birth control and other prescriptions.

He supported the "**Women in the Military Act**" that would have repealed the current law preventing military personnel and their dependents from obtaining privately funded abortions in overseas military hospitals.

His work to renew and strengthen the "**Violence Against Women Act**" included supporting amendments which require that rape survivors have the option of using emergency contraceptives.

A forceful opponent of the Justice Department's attempt to seize women's medical records on abortions from hospitals, Eliot Engel co-sponsored the "**Patients' Privacy Protection Act**" to guarantee the confidentiality of doctor-patient records and prevent seizure of patients' private records.

Congressman Eliot Engel recently received a 100% approval voting rating when NARAL Pro-Choice America issued its report on how Members of Congress voted on abortion issues.
